

Regulation of the Rolf Luft Fellowship/stipend

The fellowship is personal and not given to any university. The fellowship shall cover living costs during a post doc period (could also include travel costs) at another university/research institute. The fellowship cannot be used to pay salaries or other direct costs for research. A committee of two independent senior scientists will review and rank the applications from 1 to 5 according to the following criteria: Originality of the scientific question, methods, competence, accomplishment, the quality of the accepting institution, and the significance of the letter of recommendation. The final decision will be made by the Board of Rolf Luft Foundation for Diabetes Research.

The application in English should include the following:

- A research plan of max 2 pages,
- •CV including list of publication.
- •A short letter of recommendation.
- •A letter of invitation from the supervisor to be at the visiting university/research institute.
- •A budget for travel costs and/or personal living costs during the post doc period.

The application with the applicant's name, postal address and e-mail should be sent in 3 copies to the Rolf Luft Foundation for Diabetes Research, c/o Kerstin Brismar, Sonja Kovalevskys gata 2, 113 66 Stockholm or by email to: Kerstin.Brismar@ki.se.

Once applications are received a decision is made from the Chair of the foundation as to whether an application is eligible to be sent out for external review or not.
